**STAFF RECOMMENDATION TO CANCEL**  
**CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND TARIFF**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation respectfully states:

1. On April 3, 2006, Nationwide Professional Teleservices, LLC, (NPT) filed its verified Application to Cancel Certificate of Service Authority and Tariffs (Application) in the above-captioned case. The Staff submits its Memorandum, attached hereto as Appendix A and incorporated by reference herein, recommending the cancellation of NPT's certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff, P.S.C. Mo. Tariff No. 1, to provide interexchange telecommunications service.

2. NPT was granted a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service on December 17, 2004 in Case No. XA-2005-0130. NPT's tariff, PSC MO No. 1, was approved in the same case. NPT states in its Application that it has no customers in Missouri. Therefore, cancellation of NPT's certificate of service authority is not detrimental to the public interest. NPT has no other matters pending before the Commission.

3. Because cancellation of NPT's certificate is not detrimental to public interest, NPT's certificate should be canceled by the Commission.

4. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications corporation certificate pursuant to Section 392.410, RSMo 2000 which provides:

Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon Request of the person or company affected.

However, the Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. 1989).

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends the Commission issue an order canceling the certificate of service authority of Nationwide Professional Teleservices, LLC to provide interexchange telecommunications service and its accompanying P.S.C. MO Tariff No. 1.





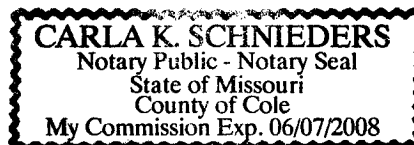

On April 3, 2006, Nationwide Professional Teleservices, LLC (NPT), a competitive telecommunications company, filed its Application to Cancel Certificate of Service Authority and Tariffs. NPT was granted a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service on December 17, 2004, in Case No. XA-2005-0130.
