## ORDER SETTING EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

Issue Date: May 22, 2014

Effective Date: May 30, 2014

On February 13, 2014, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an order ("Cancellation Order") canceling United American Technology, Inc.'s ("UAT") certificates of service authority to provide interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services within the state and associate tariffs (Tracking No. JX-2007-0783). The effective date for the Cancellation Order was February 25, 2014. On February 24<sup>th</sup>, UAT filed a *Motion to Stay Order*, stating UAT was in the process of submitting all outstanding annual reports required by Commission rules and paying all outstanding universal service fund fees. On that same day, the Commission issued an order that stayed the effective date of the Cancellation Order while UAT and the Staff of the Public Service Commission attempted to resolve all issues.

On May 7<sup>th</sup>, Staff filed *Staff's Motion to Renew the Cancellation of the Certificates of Service Authority and Associated Tariff of United American Technology*. Staff states in its motion that it received a written statement from counsel for UAT indicating UAT now wishes to cease operations in Missouri.

Staff further reports that UAT ceased working with Staff to resolve discrepancies in reports required to be filed with the Commission and that UAT is delinquent on the payment of a majority of its Missouri Universal Service Fund fees.

On May 7<sup>th</sup>, the Commission issued an order settling a May 19<sup>th</sup> deadline for UAT to file a response to Staff's motion. No response was filed by UAT.

The Commission will set an effective date for the Commission's *Order Canceling Certificate and Accompanying Tariff*.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's *Order Canceling Certificate and Accompanying Tariff*, issued on February 13, 2014, shall go into effect on May 30, 2014.
2. This file may be closed on June 2, 2014.
