ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE STATUS REPORT

On February 13, 2014, the Commission issued an order canceling United American Technology, Inc.'s ("UAT") certificates of service authority to provide interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri and its associated tariffs. The effective date for the Commission's Order was February 25, 2014.

On February 24, 2014, UAT filed a *Motion to Stay Order*, indicating UAT was in the process of filing with the Staff of the Commission all outstanding annual reports and working to pay any universal service fund fees due.

On that same day, the Commission issued its *Order Staying Effective Date of Order Canceling Certificate and Accompanying Tariff*, in which it also directed Staff to file a status report by April 1, 2014. On April 1, Staff filed a Status Report, stating that the parties are still working to acquire missing documentation and bring UAT up-to-date on all past-due reports.

Since the parties appear to need additional time, the Commission will order Staff to file a status report no later than May 20, 2014.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a status report with the Commission no later than May 20, 2014.
2. This order shall become effective on April 1, 2014.
