ORDER SUSPENDING REQUIREMENT TO FILE PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On October 24, 2007, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion asking the Commission to extend the time allowed for the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule regarding Staff's complaint against Universal Utilities, Inc. and Nancy Croasdell. Staff explains that the scope of the complaint is uncertain until the Commission rules on Staff's request for leave to file an amended complaint and a related motion to compel discovery.
