MOTION TO CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and moves for the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) to cancel the certificate of interexchange telecommunications service authority and applicable tariff of Advantage Telecommunications Corp., (Company) and states:

1. The Commission previously granted a certificate to the Company to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications service authority in Case No. TA-99-328 on March 8, 1999. The Company also has applicable tariff no. JX-2003-0075.

2. The Company filed a letter with the Commission on October 28, 2021, asking the Commission to cancel the certificate and applicable tariff of the Company. The Company states that it no longer offers telecommunications services in Missouri and that no customers will be affected.

3. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo 2000, which provides “[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

4. The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel.*

Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. W.D. 1989).

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully recommends the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services and Tariff No. JX-2003-0075 of Advantage Telecommunications Corp. and grant such other and further relief as is just in the circumstances.


