## ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFF

Issue Date: June 7, 2017

Effective Date: June 17, 2017

On May 22, 2017, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Network Utilization Services' ("Network Utilization") certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

In File Number TA-96-162, the Commission granted Network Utilization a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri. The Company's tariff, P.S.C. Mo No. 1, was also approved.

Staff states in its motion that Network Utilization contacted Staff via letter stating Network Utilization was no longer providing service in Missouri and requesting the Commission cancel Network Utilization's certificate of service authority. Staff noted that Network Utilization is deficient in the filing of the Company's annual report for calendar year 2015 and 2016 and deficient in the filing of their Statement of Revenue for 2014 through 2016. Network Utilization is also delinquent on its payment of its fiscal year 2013 assessment. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority to provide

interexchange telecommunications services, and the company's accompanying tariff.

On May 24, 2017, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Time to Respond allowing parties until June 5, 2017, to file an objection or request a hearing. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."


Based on Staff's motion, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff granted to Network Utilization Services, shall be canceled.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The certificate of authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services granted to Network Utilization Services, in File Number TA-96-162, is canceled.
2. Network Utilization Services's tariff, P.S.C. Mo No. 1, is canceled.
3. This order shall become effective on June 17, 2017.

4. This case may be closed on June 18, 2017.
