ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

On June 19, 2014, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting SNET America, Inc. ("SNET") certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide interexchange telecommunication services in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

In File Number TA-2007-0041, the Commission granted SNET a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri.

Staff states in its motion that SNET notified Staff indicating SNET was no longer providing service in Missouri and requested the Commission cancel SNET's certificate of service authority. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services.

On June 20, 2014, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than June 30, 2014. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.


The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, “[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on Staff’s motion, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to SNET America, Inc., shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The certificate of authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services granted to SNET America, Inc., in File Number TA-2007-0041, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on July 24, 2014.
3. This case may be closed on July 25, 2014.
