On January 11, 2016, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Chariton Valley L.D. Corp's ("Chariton Valley") certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri be cancelled. The Commission granted Chariton Valley a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri in File Number TA-96-314.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.<sup>1</sup> Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.
