ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION

On October 29, 2021, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a motion requesting that the Commission cancel the certificate of interexchange telecommunications service authority of Advantage Telecommunications, Corp. (Company). On March 8, 1999, the Commission granted the Company a certificate to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications service in Case No. TA-99-328. The Company also has applicable Tariff No. JX-2003-0075. Staff's motion states that the Company filed a letter with the Commission on October 28, 2021, asking the Commission to cancel the certificate and applicable tariff. The letter also states that the Company no longer offers telecommunications services in Missouri and that no customers will be affected.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the

issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.
