TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION**

On April 12, 2016, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Zoom-i-Net Communications, Inc.'s ("Zoom-i-Net") certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri be cancelled. The Commission granted Zoom-i-Net a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri in File Number XA-2005-0314. On May 19, 2015, Zoom-i-Net informed Staff that it wishes to relinquish its certificate of service authority.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.

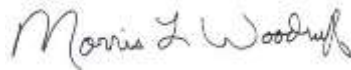
1. Anyone wishing to respond to Staff's Motion or request a hearing shall do so by filing a pleading no later than April 25, 2016, with:
