ORDER CANCELLING INTEREXCHANGE CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

Issue Date: February 28, 2022 Effective Date: March 30, 2022 On January 26, 2022, Global Tel*Link Corporation d/b/a ViaPath Technologies filed a request to cancel the certificate of service authority granted to its subsidiary, Public Communications Services. Inc. (the Company), to provide interchange telecommunication services in the State of Missouri. The Company also requested any related tariffs be canceled. The Commission granted the Company a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate telecommunication services in File No. TA-2000-787. The Company states that it has no customers in Missouri and no longer needs the certificate.

On January 27, 2022, the Commission issued an order that anyone wishing to file an objection or request a hearing do so no later than February 7, 2022. There were no such filings. The Commission need not hold a hearing if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹

On February 25, 2022, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its *Staff Report and Recommendation* in which it advised that the Company had met the requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-28.011(3). Staff recommended that the Commission

approve the cancellation of the certificate of service authority and cancel any applicable tariffs.

The Commission will follow Staff's recommendation and cancel the certificate of service authority of the Company. The Company has no currently effective tariffs on file with the Commission.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The certificate of service authority to provide interchange telecommunication services granted to Public Communications Services, Inc. in File No. TA-2000-787 is canceled.

- 3. This file shall be closed on March 31, 2022.
