

**STATUS REPORT PURSUANT TO ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER OF ASSETS, AND GRANTING A WAIVER OF 4 CSR § 240-33.150**

On February 5, 2003, the Joint Application of Matrix Telecom, Inc. and International Exchange Communications, Inc. for Approval of the Transfer of Certain Assets and Related Transactions and a Waiver of Applicable Anti-Slamming Regulations was filed. On May 29, 2003, the Commission issued an Order Approving Transfer of Assets, and Granting a Waiver of 4 CSR 240-33.150 ("Order"). In that Order, the Commission ordered as follows:

1. That the joint application of International Exchange Communications, Inc., to Matrix Telecom, Inc., for approval of a sale of assets is granted.
2. That International Exchange Communications, Inc., and Matrix Telecom, Inc., are authorized to take any and all lawful actions necessary to carry out the proposed sale of assets presented to the Commission.
3. That before Matrix Telecom, Inc., may operate in the state of Missouri as Matrix Telecom, Inc., d/b/a International Exchange Communications, Inc., it must receive authorization from the Missouri Secretary of State to use the fictitious name Matrix Telecom, Inc., d/b/a International Exchange Communications, Inc., and that Matrix shall file a copy of that authorization with the Commission.

4. That before Matrix Telecom, Inc., may operate in the state of Missouri as Matrix Telecom, Inc., d/b/a International Exchange Communications, Inc., it must be granted a certificate of service authority as Matrix Telecom, Inc., d/b/a International Exchange Communications, Inc.

5. That before Matrix Telecom, Inc., may operate in the state of Missouri as Matrix Telecom, Inc., d/b/a International Exchange Communications, Inc., it shall adopt International Exchange Communications, Inc.'s tariff.

6. That a waiver of Commission rule 4 CSR 240-33.150, Verification of Orders for Changing Telecommunications Service Provider, is granted.

7. That Matrix Telecom, Inc. d/b/a International Exchange Communications, Inc., shall notify its customers that it has assumed the provision of the telecommunications services in the next regular billing cycle of its customers after the transactions are complete.

8. That Matrix Telecom, Inc., shall file a report in this case stating the status of the transactions and conditions set out in the ordered paragraphs above no later than August 27, 2003, and continuing every 90 days until it has notified the Commission that all the conditions and transactions have been completed.


9. That this order shall become effective on June 8, 2003.

Matrix is hereby following the Commission's mandate and providing a status report regarding the transactions and conditions required by the Commission. On June 3, 2003, Matrix received authorization from the Missouri Secretary of State to use the fictitious name IE Com. Matrix filed a copy of that authorization with the Commission on August 21, 2003. Matrix Telecom, Inc. d/b/a IE Com is currently in the process of completing an Application for a Certificate of Service Authority and Competitive Classification, as well as adopting International

Exchange Communication, Inc.'s Tariff. Matrix expects to have these matters completed before the next status report which is required within 90 days of August 27, 2003.


