## ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE

On April 21, 2010, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting the cancellation of 1800Call4Less certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri. The Commission granted 1800Call4Less a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri in File Number XA-2004-0620.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.<sup>1</sup> Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to file an objection or request a hearing shall do so by filing a pleading no later than May 3, 2010, with:
