ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ANNUAL REPORTS

On March 9, 2010, Looking Glass Networks, Inc. filed an application asking the Commission to extend the time within which it is required to file its 2009 annual report from April 15, 2010, to June 15, 2010. On March 12, the Commission's Staff filed a recommendation indicating its support for an extension until June 15, 2010.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3. 540 requires all telecommunications companies to submit an annual report to the Commission on or before April 15 of each year. However, that rule allows a company to request an extension of greater than thirty days by filing a pleading before April 15, stating the reason for and the length of the requested extension.

Looking Glass' pleading meets the requirements of the rules and the relief the company requests is reasonable. Therefore, the Commission will extend the time within which Looking Glass shall file its 2009 annual reports to June 15, 2010.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The time within which Looking Glass Networks, Inc., shall file its 2009 annual reports is extended to June 15, 2010.
2. This order shall become effective on March 16, 2010.

3. This case shall be closed on March 17, 2010.
