ORDER RECOGNIZING CHANGE OF CORPORATE NAME AND APPROVING TARIFF

Issue Date: March 13, 2007 Effective Date: March 14, 2007

On February 13, 2007, Global Internetworking, Inc. ("Global Internetworking") filed a cover letter and accompanying application requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission acknowledge a corporate name change to Global Telecom & Technology Americas, Inc. ("Global Telecom") and approve amended tariff sheets reflecting that name change.

Accompanying the cover letter and application are documents showing that Global Internetworking, a Virginia corporation, amended its Articles of Incorporation to change its corporate name to Global Telecom effective November 1, 2006, and that on January 22, 2007, the Missouri Secretary of State issued Global Telecom an Amended Certificate of Authority to do business in the State of Missouri as a foreign corporation. The application notes that Global Internetworking is currently authorized to provide competitive interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri through a certificate issued by the Commission in Case Number XA-2002-1042.

Also attached are replacement tariff sheets with an effective date of March 14, 2007, including an adoption notice and a new title page, which reflect the name change and have

been designated as Tariff No. YX-2007-0561. Finally, the cover letter indicates that Global Internetworking intends to inform its customers of the name change using a bill insert, which will include both company logos.

On February 16, 2007, the Commission directed its Staff to commence an investigation and promptly file a report containing its recommendation as to whether the Commission should recognize Global Internetworking's name change and approve the accompanying revised tariff sheets. On March 9, 2007, the Staff of the Commission filed a verified Memorandum recommending that the Commission recognize Global Internetworking's name change to Global Telecom and approve the accompanying tariff sheets with an effective date of March 14, 2007, further indicating that the company's customers will be notified of the name change at or before the next billing cycle. Staff notes that Global Internetworking's letter and application comply with the applicable Commission Rules governing utility company name changes and setting forth filing requirements for telecommunications company tariffs.¹

The Commission has reviewed Global Internetworking's pleadings and Staff's Memorandum, and finds that the change of name to Global Telecom will be recognized. The Commission further finds that the revised tariff reflecting the change of name will be approved.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The change of name from Global Internetworking, Inc. to Global Telecom & Technology Americas, Inc. is recognized.
- 2. Global Telecom & Technology Americas, Inc.'s revised tariff, Tariff No. YX-2007-0561, is approved to become effective on March 14, 2007. The tariff approved is:
