

following to the Commission:


1. In its Order of November 5, 2002, the Commission directed that the  
Applicants file a notice with the Commission that they have completed the proposed  
transaction no later than ten (10) business days after the transaction has occurred. The  
Commission further ordered that the Applicants must, by January 14, 2003, file a notice  
with the Commission that they have complied with the notice provisions of the Order.

2. The Applicants anticipate that completion of the transaction approved in  
this matter will not occur in Missouri until after January 14, 2003. As a consequence, it  
needs additional time to file a notification with the Commission that it has complied with  
all provisions of the Order.

3. Although the Applicants are moving diligently toward completing this  
transaction, the Applicants request additional time, at least until February 15, 2003, to file  
a notice of completion of the transaction.


