## ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND

On July 3, 2006, Electric Lightwave, LLC, filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking approval to adopt the “doing business as” name Integra Telecom and to operate under that name in Missouri. Electric Lightwave’s application was not in compliance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240.2.060 (5), in that it lacked two of three required elements. First, the application did not include evidence of registration of the name change with the Missouri Secretary of State. Second, the application was not accompanied by either an adoption notice and revised title sheet with an effective date which is not fewer than thirty (30) days after the filing date of the application or a revised tariff with an effective date which is not fewer than thirty (30) days after the filing date of the application. On July 6, 2006, the Commission issued an order directing filing which required Electric Lightwave to file a supplemental pleading curing these defects in compliance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060 (5), on or before July 14, 2006.

On July 12, 2006, Electric Lightwave filed a request seeking an extension until August 14, 2006, to file the required supplemental pleading. In support of its request, Electric Lightwave stated that it would be unable to obtain register with the Missouri

Secretary of State until it completes certain corporate actions. To ensure the Commission would have time to review its filing after receipt of the supplemental filing, Electric Lightwave voluntarily extended its pending tariff's effective date from August 1<sup>st</sup> to September 1<sup>st</sup>.

The request for extension of time is reasonable and will be granted.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Electric Lightwave, LLC's, Request for Extension of Time is granted.
2. Electric Lightwave, LLC, shall file its supplemental pleading curing the defects in its original application no later than August 14, 2006.
3. This order shall become effective on July 28, 2006.
