The Commission is giving notice of the commencement of a contested case, which is a formal hearing procedure.

By order dated October 6, 2010, the Commission suspended the tariff for which this file opened. The Commission shall suspend a tariff only in conjunction with:

> . . . a hearing concerning the propriety of such [tariff]; and pending such hearing and the decision thereon the commission, . . . and after full hearing, whether completed before or after the [tariff] goes into effect, the commission may make such order in reference to such [tariff] as would be proper in a proceeding initiated after the [tariff] had become effective [.1]

The order of suspension instituted a contested case because that order triggered the right to a "full" pre-decision hearing.²

The hearing is subject to waiver, as are other pre-decision procedural formalities.⁴ and a decision is also possible through stipulation and agreement.⁵ This
