ORDER GRANTING CLARIFICATION

The motion to clarify (“motion”),¹ filed by KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”), clarifies the calculation underlying the *Typical Residential Customer Impact* (“statement”)² filed by Staff but does not alter the statement. Staff’s statement constituted Staff’s:

. . . response to the Commission’s order of September 23, 2016, by which it directed the parties to “set forth the monthly increase or monthly decrease, as a dollar amount and as a percentage, for the average residential customer’s bill in GMO’s two service areas, L&P and MPS.” Based on an average usage of 900 kWh and 1,300 kWh, respectively for customers who do not and who do use electricity for space heating, the bill impacts . . . follow. [³]

Accordingly, the Commission’s order to file compliance tariffs (“order”)⁴ described such impacts in GMO’s two service areas, L&P and MPS, based on an average usage of 900 kWh and 1,300 kWh, respectively as part of the table (“original table”) in which the order set forth the estimated impacts:⁵

GMO filed a response to the statement agreeing with the statement's calculations.⁶

The motion states that the statement's calculations are based on an average usage of 900 kWh and 1,300 kWh, respectively for the rate classifications of General Use and Space Heating in GMO's two service areas, L&P and MPS.⁷ The motion states that the statement:

. . . used a 900 kWh average use assumption for "General Use" customers in both MPS and L&P service areas and a 1300 kWh average use assumption for "Space Heating" customers in both MPS and L&P service areas. [⁸]

The motion includes a substitute table:⁹

The substitute table only clarifies the basis of the estimated impacts. The estimated impacts are unchanged as to dollar amounts and percentages.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. *KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's Motion for Clarification* ("motion") is granted.

2. The *Order Approving Stipulations and Agreements, Rejecting Tariffs, Cancelling True-Up Hearing, and Ordering Filing of Compliance Tariffs* is clarified, by deleting the original table described in the body of this order, and inserting in lieu thereof the substitute table described in the body of this order.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.

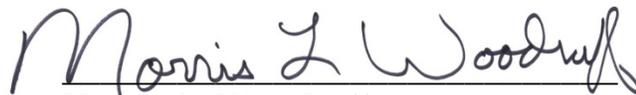
