ORDER CLOSING CASE

On January 26, 2007, Better World Telecom, Inc. ("BWTI") filed a letter notifying the Missouri Public Service Commission of a corporate name change to BetterWorld Telecom, LLC. Attached to the letter was a complete set of replacement tariff sheets with an effective date of February 26, 2007. According to the letter, the replacement tariff, which was assigned Tariff Tracking No. YX-2007-0520, contained not only the usual *pro formatype* modifications associated with a corporate name change, but also *substantive* revisions (including both increases and decreases) to the various rates to be charged by BWTI and paid by its customers.

In an order dated January 31, 2007, the Commission found that while the letter and attachments were in substantial compliance with the applicable Commission Rules governing the contents of applications for corporate name changes, they were not in compliance with 4 CSR 240-3.545(12) and (15), which contain certain specific filing requirements for tariffs submitted by Commission-regulated telecommunications companies which involve changes in rates or charges. Accordingly, the Commission's order of

January 31, 2007 gave BWTI two weeks (*i.e.*, until February 13, 2007) to provide the missing information in an appropriate supplemental pleading.¹

However, on February 6, 2007, BWTI filed a letter withdrawing its request that the Commission recognize its corporate name change. As a result, the replacement tariff (Tariff No. YX-2007-0520) was also withdrawn in its entirety, leaving nothing for the Commission to determine. Therefore, this case shall be closed.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. This case shall be closed on the effective date of this order.
- 2. This order shall become effective on February 17, 2007.
