The Commission should require Ameren to present rigorous economic assessments of alternative near-term retirement dates for each of the Rush Island, Labadie, and Sioux units in its next general rate case. These forward-looking assessments should incorporate up-to-date assumptions regarding market prices, resource costs, and environmental compliance costs.

2. The MIEC takes no position on the other issues listed in the List of Issues.
