**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On July 3, 2006, Electric Lightwave, LLC, filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking approval to adopt the "doing business as" name Integra Telecom and to operate under that name in Missouri.

An application for name change filed with the Commission must comply with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060 (5). Electric Lightwave's application was not in compliance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240.2.060 (5), in that it lacked two of three required elements. First, the application did not include evidence of registration of the name change with the Missouri Secretary of State. Second, the application was not accompanied by either an adoption notice and revised title sheet with an effective date which is not fewer than thirty (30) days after the filing date of the application or a revised tariff with an effective date which is not fewer than thirty (30) days after the filing date of the application.

Electric Lightwave will be required to file a supplemental pleading curing these defects in compliance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060 (5).

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Electric Lightwave, LLC, shall file, no later than July 14, 2006, a supplemental pleading which shall include evidence of registration of the name change with the Missouri Secretary of State.
2. Electric Lightwave, LLC, shall file, no later than July 14, 2006, either an adoption notice and revised title sheet with an effective date which is not fewer than thirty (30) days after the filing date of the application or a revised tariff with an effective date which is not fewer than thirty (30) days after the filing date of the application.
3. This order shall become effective on July 6, 2006.
