## ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO FURTHER MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On February 14, 2020, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri), on behalf of all the parties except Consumers Council of Missouri, filed a motion requesting that certain procedural dates be amended. Ameren Missouri relates that the parties have been engaged in settlement discussions and have agreed in principle to a settlement of all rate design issues. In anticipation of filing a formal settlement agreement, the parties request that the requirement to file rate design surrebuttal testimony be suspended.

The Commission has considered the request and determines that it should be granted. The Commission will alter the procedural schedule as set out below.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Motion to Further Modify Procedural Schedule filed on February 14, 2020, by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri is granted.
- 2. The requirement to file surrebuttal testimony regarding rate design issues on February 18, 2020, is suspended.
