ORDER CLARIFYING ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Issue Date: February 13, 2020 Effective Date: February 13, 2020

The Commission issued an Order Granting Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule. In Ordered Paragraph 2.a., that order states that surrebuttal testimony with regard to certain issues that the parties have not yet reached an agreement upon shall be filed on February 14, 2020. The order did not, however, specifically state that the requirement to file surrebuttal testimony on the resolved revenue requirement issues was suspended. The Commission will clarify its previous order by adding a sentence to make clear that only surrebuttal testimony regarding the issues not resolved by agreement among the parties as set out in their motion to modify must be filed on February 14, 2020.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Order Granting Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule issued on February 13, 2020, is clarified so that Ordered Paragraph 2.a. reads as follows:
 - a. Surrebuttal Testimony shall be filed no later than February 14, 2020, on the affiliate transaction issue raised by the Office of the Public Counsel's witness, Robert Schallenberg; the Fuel Adjustment Clause sharing percentage issue raised by Office of the Public Counsel's witness, Lena Mantle; and the issues raised by the Sierra Club. The requirement to file surrebuttal testimony on all other revenue requirement issues is suspended.

2. This order is effective when issued.
