ORDER APPROVING FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE TRUE-UP

On July 1, 2016, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") filed an application for its fifteenth Fuel Adjustment Clause ("FAC") true-up filing. The filing identifies the over-recovery of GMO's FAC for the 12 months in Recovery Period 15 (March 1, 2015 through February 29, 2016). GMO operates in two rate districts, "MPS" and "L&P." During Recovery Period 15, GMO states that it over-recovered \$3,202,215¹ from MPS customers, and over-recovered \$815,474² from customers in its L&P rate district.

The over-recovered amounts for the MPS and L&P rate districts, including accumulated interest, are included in GMO's calculation of its proposed Fuel Adjustment Rates in the FAC adjustment filling currently before the Commission in File No. ER-2017-0001. On August 1, the Commission's Staff filed a recommendation on GMO's true-up filling, as required by Commission rule 4 CSR 240-20.090(5)(D). Based on its examination and analysis of information filed by GMO, including the direct testimony of

Linda Nunn and supporting schedules, Staff recommends the Commission approve GMO's true-up filing amounts for Recovery Period 15.

Based on the direct testimony of Linda Nunn and the uncontested recommendation of Staff, the Commission will approve GMO's true-up filing. The Commission will allow this order to go into effect in less than thirty days so that it may coincide with the Commission's order in File No. ER-2017-0001.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. KCP&L Greater Missouri Operation Company's true-up filing for the fifteenth recovery period (March 1, 2015 through February 29, 2016) is approved.
 - 2. This order shall be effective on September 1, 2016.
 - 3. This file shall be closed on September 2, 2016.
