ORDER DIRECTING FILING

The Commission held an evidentiary hearing on January 22-24. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Regulatory Law Judge ordered the parties to file briefs no later than February 20, with the presumption that the transcript would be filed on February 5.

The Commission's EFIS system shows the transcript was, indeed, filed on February 5, so the Commission again orders the parties to file briefs no later than February 20. The Commission encourages parties to include proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in those briefs.

Furthermore, during the hearing, the bench questioned an Algonquin witness about the valuation of its three Missouri properties.¹ The Commission will order Algonquin to report that valuation, and will allow the other parties time to respond.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Algonquin Water Resources of Missouri, LLC shall respond to the above-referenced Commission concern regarding the valuation of its Missouri properties no later than February 13, 2007.
2. Any party who wishes to respond to the pleading ordered in paragraph 1 may do so no later than February 16, 2007.
3. The parties shall file briefs no later than February 20, 2007.
4. This order shall become effective on February 6, 2007.
