

**VCI COMPANY REQUEST FOR CANCELLATION OF
CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND TARIFF**

With this filing, VCI Company ("VCI" or "Company") requests the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") to cancel the Company's Certificate of Service Authority ("Certificate") and local exchange services tariff ("Tariff"). In support of its request, VCI provides the following information:

1. The undersigned is a duly elected officer of VCI and is authorized to request cancellation of the company's Certificate and Tariff.
2. VCI was granted a Certificate by order issued March 31, 2006 in MoPSC Case No. CA-2006-0323.
3. In connection therewith, VCI's Tariff, Missouri PSC Tariff No. 1, is on file with the Commission.
4. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications corporation certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo, which provides:

Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.
5. The Commission need not hold a hearing if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. 1989).

6. VCI has not initiated service in Missouri, has no Missouri customers and is not in possession of any deposits or prepayments pertaining to Missouri intrastate service.
7. VCI will not initiate service in Missouri.
8. Cancellation of VCI's Certificate and Tariff is not detrimental to the public interest.



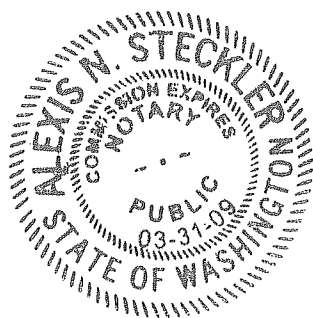
