**RECOMMENDATION TO SUSPEND TARIFF**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), through the undersigned counsel, and recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") suspend the proposed tariff revisions included in the tariff filing JC-2013-0026, and respectfully states the following:

1. On July 10, 2012, YMax Communications Corp. ("YMax") filed tariff revisions that were assigned the tariff tracking number JC-2013-0026. The filing was revised on July 31, 2012, and is presently dated to become effective on August 10, 2012.

2. The Staff cannot presently determine whether the proposed revisions comply with Missouri law and comport with the company's existing tariff before the tariff effective date and asks that the Commission grant The AT&T Companies' Motion to suspend the tariff filing. The Staff suggests that the tariff filing be suspended for a period of sixty days. If the matter can be resolved more quickly, the Staff will, in its recommendation to approve the filing, ask that the suspension be lifted and the tariff filing made effective on a certain date. If the 60-day period is not sufficient, the Staff will request a further suspension.

**WHEREFORE**, the Staff respectfully requests that the Commission suspend the YMax tariff filing referred to as JC-2013-0026.
