ORDER DIRECTING THAT PREVIOUS ORDER BE SENT TO VOIP CARRIERS

On February 1, 2012, the Commission, acting at the request of the Missouri Universal Service Board, approved a decrease of the Missouri Universal Service Fund (MoUSF) assessment rate from .0029 to .0025, effective April 1, 2012. That order directed the Commission's Data Center to send a copy of the order to all interexchange carriers, competitive local exchange carriers, and incumbent local exchange carriers doing business in Missouri.

On March 15, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to order its Data Center to send a copy of the February 1 order to all Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) carriers doing business in Missouri and registered as such in the Commission's Electronic Filing Information System (EFIS). The Commission will do so.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall send a copy of the Commission's February 1, 2012 Order Granting Intervention and Decreasing Assessment Rate to all Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) carriers doing business in Missouri and registered as such in the Commission's Electronic Filing Information System (EFIS).

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
