

On January 7, 2010, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than January 19, 2010. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, “[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on Staff’s motion, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to 1-800-RECONEX, Inc., and the accompanying tariff, shall be canceled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The certificate of authority to provide intrastate interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services granted to 1-800-RECONEX, Inc., in File No. TA-2001-389, is canceled.
2. 1-800-RECONEX, Inc.’s tariff, PSC Mo. Tariff No. 2, is canceled.
3. This order shall become effective on February 1, 2010.
4. This case may be closed on February 2, 2010.
