ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFF

Issue Date: May 30, 2013

Effective Date: June 9, 2013

On May 16, 2013, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Digizip.com, Inc. ("Digizip") certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunication services in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

In File Number XA-2004-0594, the Commission granted Digizip a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri. The Company's tariff, P.S.C. Mo No. 1, was also approved.

Staff states in its motion that Digizip contacted Staff via letter stating Digizip was no longer providing service in Missouri and requested the Commission cancel Digizip's certificate of service authority. Staff noted that Digizip is deficient in the filing of the Company's annual report for calendar year 2008 through 2011. Digizip is also delinquent on its payment of its fiscal year 2012 assessment. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services, and the company's accompanying tariff.

On May 17, 2013, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than May 28, 2013. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.


The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, “[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on Staff’s motion, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff granted to Digizip.com, Inc., shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The certificate of authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services granted to Digizip.com, Inc., in File Number XA-2004-0594, is canceled.
2. Digizip.com, Inc.’s tariff, P.S.C. Mo No. 1, is canceled.
3. This order shall become effective on June 9, 2013.
4. This case may be closed on June 10, 2013.
