On June 19, 2008, Seges Partners Mobile Home Park, L.L.C. ("Seges"), filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission. It requests a certificate of convenience and necessity to operate a water system.

On March 20, 2009, the Staff of the Commission ("Staff") filed a Status Report. Staff stated that it has most of the information from Seges that it needs to file a recommendation. Staff further explained that it needs another thirty days to allow time for the remaining information from Seges to arrive, and to allow Staff time to evaluate all of Seges information.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings. However, because granting Staff's request would cause no harm to Seges, the Commission will take up the request unopposed.

The Commission finds Staff's request reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a Recommendation or Status Report no later than April 22, 2009.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
