ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTIONS AND ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On January 13, 2014, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.060, 4 CSR 240-3.105, and Section 393.170 RSMo, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren") applied to the Missouri Public Service Commission for a certificate of convenience and necessity to build solar generation facilities in O'Fallon, Missouri. The Commission received timely interventions requests from: The Missouri Division of Energy ("MDE"), Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers ("MIEC"), and Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri ("Renew Missouri"). Ameren replied on February 6, stating that it has no objection to those applicants becoming intervenors.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4) allows the Commission to grant intervention to a person who has an interest different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or if granting intervention would serve the public interest. Upon review of the unopposed applications, the Commission finds that the applicants meet the standard in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4). Therefore, the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

The Commission further finds that this is an appropriate time to set a prehearing conference.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The applications to intervene filed by The Missouri Division of Energy, Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, and Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri are granted.
2. The prehearing conference shall be held on February 19, 2014, beginning at 1:00 p.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. That room is in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
