On January 13, 2014¹, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.060, 4 CSR 240-3.105, and Section 393.170 RSMo, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren") applied to the Missouri Public Service Commission for a certificate of convenience and necessity to build solar generation facilities in O'Fallon, Missouri. The Commission received timely interventions requests from: The Missouri Division of Energy ("MDE"), Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers ("MIEC"), and Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri ("Renew Missouri"). Ameren replied on February 6, stating that it has no objection to those applicants becoming intervenors.

On February 26, Renew Missouri filed a Proposed Procedural Schedule on behalf of the parties. At the moment, the Commission finds the schedule reasonable. The Commission appreciates the parties' "agreement" to make closing arguments in lieu of briefs. However, should it find them necessary, the Commission reserves the right to subsequently order the parties to file briefs.
