NOTICE OF CONTESTED CASE AND HEARINGS, AND ORDER GOVERNING FILINGS

The Missouri Public Service Commission is giving notice that a contested case began when the Commission issued its *Order Regarding Tariffs and Disposition Agreement*.¹ The Commission is also setting hearings and a conference, and directing certain filings. This notice does not require any party to file an answer. The Commission's discovery regulations are at 4 CSR 240-2.090.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Hearings and Conference. The Commission will convene evidentiary hearings and a conference as follows.

- a. Each hearing or conference will convene in Room 305, Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, except that the June 5 hearing date may move to Room 310.

- b. That building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. - c. Staff shall coordinate proposed orders, and jointly file proposed orders on behalf of all parties in agreement.
- d. Any proposed order setting a procedural schedule shall:
 - i. Include proposed dates for discovery service, responses, conferences, and rulings.
 - ii. Reflect the number of days required for an evidentiary hearing, and need not include all dates reserved in this order.

3. Notice of this Action. The Commission’s Data Center shall serve a copy of this notice and order upon the county commission of each county within Terre du Lac Corporation’s service

area. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Terre du Lac Corporation's service area and the news media serving Terre du Lac Corporation's service area.

4. Effective Date of this Notice and Order. This notice and order shall become effective immediately on issuance.
