REGISTRATION TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE

On June 21, 2016, CallCatchers Inc., d/b/a FreedomVoice Systems ("Company") pursuant to §392.550 and §392.611.4, RSMo, filed an application for registration to provide interexchange telecommunications service in exchanges statewide in the State of Missouri.

On July 1, 2016, Staff filed a recommendation which recommended that the Commission grant FreedomVoice a certificate of service authority and competitive status. Staff also recommended the following additional conditions –

The Company will undertake all necessary measures to ensure its contracts with underlying carriers do not contain provisions preventing delivery of traffic to any telephone exchange area of Missouri. Such measures include, but are not limited to:

- 1) Prevention of call blocking and/or call gapping based on the cost of traffic termination.
- 2) Preventing the alteration or stripping of Calling party Number identification.
- 3) Ensuring sufficient network capacity exists to process all traffic according to industry accepted practices.

The Commission has reviewed the application filed by the Company and finds that it and the attached affidavit comply with the filing requirements set forth in § 392.550, RSMo.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. CallCatchers Inc., d/b/a FreedomVoice Systems is granted authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service in the exchanges set forth in the affidavit attached to the application and restated above.
- 2. CallCatchers Inc., d/b/a FreedomVoice Systems' certificate is granted with Staff's additional conditions, as outlined above.
- 3. CallCatchers Inc., d/b/a FreedomVoice Systems' services shall be classified as competitive.
- 4. Pursuant to Section 392.410, RSMo, the authority conferred by the certificate of service authority shall be null and void unless it is exercised within one year of its issuance.
 - 5. This order shall become effective on July 15, 2016.
 - 6. The file shall be closed on July 16, 2016.
