NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING NAME CHANGE AND CLOSING FILE

Issue Date: October 28, 2014

On October 2, 2014, the above-referenced company notified the Commission of a name change and filed a tariff revision bearing an effective date of November 2, 2014. The requirements for a name change are as follows:

- a statement clearly setting out both the old and new name
- registration of fictitious name with the Missouri Secretary of State
- a copy of the notice sent to customer
- an adoption notice and revised tariff title sheet reflecting the new name, with an effective date of at least 10 days after filing
- A statement that the company has reviewed its contact information in EFIS

On October 24, the Staff of the Commission filed a pleading recommending that the Commission recognize the company's name change.

The Commission herein recognizes the company's name change from Network Communications International Corp., to Network Communications International Corp. d/b/a

NCIC Inmate Phone Service. There remains no further action in this matter. This file is therefore closed.
