ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFF

Issue Date: December 21, 2011 Effective Date: December 30, 2011

On December 6, 2011, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Pacific South Telecom, Inc. ("Pacific South") certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide competitive intrastate interexchange telecommunication services in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

In File Number LO-2008-0294, the Commission granted Pacific South a certificate of service authority to provide competitive intrastate interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri. The Company's tariff, P.S.C. Mo No. 1, was also approved.

Staff states in its motion that Pacific South submitted a letter which indicated that the company has not and does not plan to do business in Missouri. Pacific South is current in its payment of assessments to the Commission. Pacific South is not deficient in the filing of the Company's annual report. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority to provide competitive intrastate interexchange telecommunications services, and the company's accompanying tariff.

On December 9, 2011, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than December 19, 2011. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on Staff's motion, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff granted to Pacific South Telecom, Inc., shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The certificate of authority to provide competitive intrastate interexchange telecommunications services granted to Pacific South Telecom, Inc., in File Number LO-2008-0294, is canceled.
 - 2. Pacific South Telecom, Inc.'s tariff, P.S.C. Mo No. 1, is canceled.
 - 3. This order shall become effective on December 30, 2011.

4. This case may be closed on December 31, 2011.
