ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

Issue Date: July 27, 2005 Effective Date: August 6, 2005

On July 12, 2005, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion to cancel the certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services granted to Clear Call Telecom, LLC, in Case No. TA-2001-332. Staff also requests that the Commission cancel the company's tariff, P.S.C. Mo. Tariff No. 1.

In support of its motion, Staff informs the Commission that Clear Call defaulted in a complaint case before the Commission in Case No. TC-2004-0339. The company also defaulted in the related circuit court case, Case No. 04CV325241. Staff also states that according to the Missouri Secretary of State, Clear Call was dissolved on March 4, 2005.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) states that parties shall not be allowed more than ten days in which to file a responsive pleading. More than ten days have expired since Staff filed its motion, yet the company has not responded.

Section 392.410(5), RSMo 2000, states that "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected. . . ." The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion and finds that granting the motion is reasonable. The Commission

will cancel the certificate of service authority granted to Clear Call Telecom, LLC, in Case No. TA-2001-332. The Commission will also cancel the company's tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services, granted to Clear Call Telecom, LLC, in Case No. TA-2001-332, is canceled.
- 2. That the tariff, P.S.C. Mo. Tariff No. 1, approved for Clear Call Telecom, LLC, in Case No. TA-2001-332, is canceled.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on August 6, 2005.
 - 4. That this case may be closed on August 7, 2005.
