**ORDER RECOGNIZING NAME CHANGE  
AND APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS**

On October 5, 2011, the Commission received the above-referenced request for name change. Accompanying the request was the above-referenced tariff, bearing an effective date of November 4, 2011.

On October 25, 2011, Staff filed its Recommendation. Staff stated that the applicant has complied with the Commission rule regarding name changes. Further, Staff recommended the Commission recognize the name change and approve the tariff sheets.

The Commission has reviewed the application, finds that it substantially complies with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.062, and finds that it should recognize the name change. The Commission will also approve the revised tariff.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission recognizes the name change of Computer Telephone Corp. d/b/a ONE Communications to CTC Communications Corp. d/b/a EarthLink Business.

2. The Commission approves the tariff sheets CTC Communications Corp. d/b/a EarthLink Business filed on October 25, 2011, reflecting its new name. Those tariff sheets were assigned tariff file number JX-2012-0143, and are approved for service on and after November 4, 2011. The tariff sheets approved are:
