Dear Secretary:

On February 1, 2016, Laclede Gas Company ("Company") filed <u>P.S.C. MO. No. 5 Consolidated</u>, <u>Twenty-Sixth Revised Sheet No. 12</u> to change the Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge ("ISRS") applicable to the Laclede Gas operating unit of the Company. The Commission issued an order on February 3rd suspending Laclede's ISRS tariff until May 31st. On April 12th, the Commission issued an order setting an April 26th evidentiary hearing on Laclede's application. An evidentiary hearing was held on April 26th. The parties filed post-hearing briefs on May 4th, and the Commission issued a Report and Order ("Order") on May 19th. Pursuant to the Order, attached is a compliance tariff which has an issue date of May 19, 2016 and an effective date of June 18, 2016. However, the Company requests that the Commission approve such sheet to be effective on May 31, 2016 consistent with the effective date of the Order.

INFRASTRUCTURE SYSTEM REPLACEMENT SURCHARGE ("ISRS")

<u>Description</u>: The ISRS is designed to recover the costs associated with the Company's eligible infrastructure replacements in accordance with the provisions of Sections 393.1009 to 393.1015, RSMo.

<u>Applicability</u>: In addition to the other charges provided for in the Company's tariff, a monthly ISRS shall be added to each customer's bill for service rendered on and after the effective date of the ISRS.
