

MISSOURI UNIVERSAL SERVICE FUND

- 1. Company will place on each end retail end-user customer's bill, a surcharge equal to the Missouri Universal Service Fund percentage assessment ordered by the Commission.

C. Inside Wiring

Exposed wiring is the standard method of wiring a customer's premises.

If suitable interior conduit is provided by the customer, the Telephone Company will install its wiring and cable therein without additional charge. Where the customer desires concealed wiring and or cable and does not provide suitable interior conduit, the customer shall pay the difference between the cost of concealing the wiring and or cable and the estimated cost which would prevail under normal wiring and cable installation methods.

Where, due to the unusual or peculiar construction of the building occupied by the customer, unusual installation expense is incurred or it is necessary to employ nonstandard methods of wiring and cable installation the customer shall pay the additional expense involved.

EXTENSION STATIONS

Extension stations may be provided in connection with all classes of service. Business extensions will be installed in a residence upon application of appropriate mileage charges provided there is a residence main station maintained.

Extension stations may be furnished in connection with residence service provided they are located on the same premises as the main station.

The term "on the same premises" shall be construed to mean that area which includes the building where the main station is located and all other contiguous outbuildings usually found immediately adjacent to all rural dwelling. Extension stations may be installed at locations not on the same premises as the main station upon application of the appropriate mileage chargen - 1 1983

Public Service Commission

1. Applications for Service

Applications for service shall constitute a contract when accepted in writing by the Telephone Company or upon the establishment of service. The initial minimum period for which charges shall apply will be 30 days. An applicant who has no account with the Telephone Company, or whose financial responsibility is not a matter of common knowledge, may be required to make an advance payment at the time application is made in an amount equal to the charges for one month's local service plus the service connection, installation, or construction charges that may be applicable.

2. Telephone Numbers

The subscriber has no property right in the telephone number and the Telephone Company may change any number at any time whenever it deems it advisable in the conduct of its business.

3. Alterations

The subscriber agrees to notify the Telephone Company promptly whenever alterations or new construction on premises owned or leased by him will necessitate changes in the Telephone Company's wiring and equipment; and the subscriber agrees to pay the Telephone Company's current charges, if any, for such changes.

4. Responsibility of Subscriber for Payment

The subscriber is required to pay all charges for exchange services and facilities, and for toll messages in accordance with provisions contained elsewhere in these Tariffs. The subscriber is held responsible for all charges for telephone service rendered at his telephone, both exchange and toll, including charges for toll messages on which the charges have been reversed.

Maintenance and Repair

The Telephone Company undertakes to maintain and repair the facilities which it furnishes to subscribers. The subscriber agrees to take good care of the instruments, and all accessories connected therewith and shall be responsible for all malicious, willful, and negligent damage. The subscriber may not, nor permit others to, rearrange, disconnect or remove any equipment or wiring installed by the response Company. 1. Service may be discontinued for any of the following reasons:

a. Non-payment of an undisputed delinquent charge.

- Failure to post a required deposit or guarantee.
- c. Unauthorized use of the telephone company's equipment in a manner which creates an unsafe condition or creates the possibility of damage or destruction to such equipment.
- d. Failure to substantially comply with the terms of a settlement agreement.
- e. Refusal after reasonable notice to permit inspection, maintenance, or replacement of the telephone company's equipment.
- Material misrepresentation of identity in obtaining telephone utility service.
- As provided by state or federal law.
- h. Non-payment of undisputed, delinquent state or interstate long distance service charges billed by the company or undisputed, delinquent exchange service charges including any FCC approved end user charge or both, with the exception of Lifeline Service.
- 2. The failure to pay charges not subject to Commission jurisdiction shall not constitute cause for discontinuance of service except as indicated in 1.h above.
- 3. A written notice shall be sent by first class mail five (5) days prior to discontinuance of service.
- 4. Service may be discontinued during normal business hours on or after the date specified in the notice of discontinuance. Service shall not be discontinued on a day when the offices of the telephone company are not open to facilitate reconnection of service, or on a day immediately preceding such day. Service shall not be discontinued for non-payment of a delinquent charge until five (5) days after a charge has become delinquent.

10. Installation Charges and the appropriate NID material charge apply when a preinted afformation is made for the sole purpose of installing a customer requested NID.

- 11. The Company shall not be liable for shortages of coins collected and deposited at the subscriber's equipment. The limit of the Company's liability for end user fraud of whatever nature occurring at or in association with the subscriber's equipment shall be governed by provisions of this Tariff and rule or regulations of the Missouri Public Service Commission. In case of conflict between the tariff provisions and Commission rules and regulations, the rule or regulations shall prevail.
- 12. Off-Premise Extensions are not permitted.
- 13. Local messages from Payphones are charged at no higher than twenty-five (25) cents for each call. Upon implementation of the FCC rules preempting state regulations of payphone rates, this subsection will not apply.
- 14. The Multiline Business Subscriber Line Charge, found in the interstate access tariff, is applicable to all payphone Instrument and CO Implemented coin lines.

B. Responsibility of the Customer

- 1. The Customer for the purposes of this tariff is defined as the Payphone Service Provider.
- 2. The customer shall be responsible for the installation, operation and maintenance of the customer-provided instrument, plus all ancillary equipment, such as booths, shelves, lighting, directories, etc., used in connection with this service. The customer is responsible for complying with the requirements set forth in the American With Disabilities Act of 1990.

The customer-provided instrument must be registered in compliance with Part 68 of the FCC's Registration Program. In addition, the customer must comply with the Missouri Public Service Commission's Rules and Regulations regarding the use of customer-provided pay telephones.
