Enclosed for filing on behalf of Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L"), please find 1<sup>st</sup> Revised Sheet No. 50.1 Canceling Sheet Original Sheet No. 50.1, bearing an issue date of November 6, 2015 and a proposed effective date of December 6, 2015. Also enclosed, for the convenience of the Commission and other recipients, is a red-line version of Sheet No. 50.1 showing the proposed revisions.
