ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND TARIFF

Issue Date: December 22, 2015 Effective Date: January 4, 2016

The Commission granted an application ("the previous action") for a public water district to acquire Ozark Shores Water Company ("Ozark Shores"), ¹ and that transaction closed on December 14, 2015.²

The Commission gave all parties to the previous action an opportunity to show cause why the Commission should not cancel Ozark Shores' tariff and certificate of convenience and necessity ("certificate"). Only Ozark Shores responded, and states that it has no objection to canceling the tariff and certificate. ³ Therefore, the Commission will cancel the tariff and certificate.

The absence of opposition to this order, and of any regulated entity authorized to do business under Ozark Shores' tariff and certificate, constitute good cause to make this order effective less than 30 days after issuance. ⁴
