ORDER APPROVING INTERIM RATES

Issue Date: September 24, 2013

Effective Date: October 1, 2013

On September 9, 2013¹, M.P.B, Inc., ("M.P.B") initiated a small company revenue increase request pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.050. On September 19, M.P.B. filed tariff sheets intended to implement an emergency rate increase.

The tariff sheets are effective October 19. However, M.P.B. asks the Commission to approve the sheets to be effective October 1.

The Staff of the Commission ("Staff") and the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC") responded on September 20. Staff and OPC both state that the tariff sheets conform to the parties' agreement in a related receivership case.² Staff recommends the Commission approve the tariff sheets as soon as possible. OPC states that it has no objection to the tariff sheets becoming effective on October 1.

The Commission has authority to issue interim rate increases.³ Upon review of the pleadings, the Commission finds that the tariff sheets comport with the parties' prior agreement, and the Commission will therefore approve the tariff sheets. Further, the Commission finds that good cause exists for the tariff sheets to become effective in less than thirty days; therefore, the Commission will approve the tariff to become effective October 1.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following tariff filed on September 19, 2013, and assigned Tariff No. YS-2014-0130, is approved to become effective on October 1, 2013:
