These tariff sheets are being issued May 21, 2018 to become effective on and after January 1, 2019.

The new original sheets implement a Renewable Energy Standard Rate Adjustment Mechanism ("RESRAM") and the revised sheets incorporate language referencing the RESRAM where applicable on all of the rate schedules, and add a reference to the Rider itself to the Table of Contents. The significant regulatory lag the Company would face in adding wind generation to meet the requirements of Missouri's Renewable Energy Standard necessitates the implementation of a RESRAM.

The proposed tariff sheets were communicated to the Missouri Public Service Commission Staff prior to filing, and an initial discussion was held to bring to light any possible issues.
