RE: Case No. GR-2015-????, Missouri Gas Energy

Attached for filing on behalf of Missouri Gas Energy is an electronic version of P.S.C. MO. No. 6, Third Revised Sheet No. 24.3, canceling Second Revised Sheet No. 24.3. This tariff sheet bears an issue date of February 13, 2015, and a proposed effective date of March 1, 2015.

By this filing, MGE proposes to make an adjustment to the Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) Rate as permitted under the provisions of Sheet No. 15 of MGE's tariff. MGE is proposing to adjust the Current Cost of Gas Factor (C.C.G.).

The proposed PGA Rate of \$0.53209 which includes a Filing Adjustment Factor (FAF) of \$(0.03) reflects a 22.37% decrease in gas costs and a decrease of \$0.15331 per Ccf over the PGA Rate currently in effect of \$0.6854. The change in the PGA Rate reflects a decrease in the C.C.G. Factor of \$0.15331 per Ccf which is primarily attributable to a decrease in the wholesale price of gas.

The proposed PGA would decrease the average natural gas bill of the typical residential customer by approximately 14% which amounts to an average decrease of \$126 per year or about \$10.49 per month, but such bill impacts may be less or more depending on the effect of weather and other factors on customer usage.

Workpapers supporting the calculations performed in developing the proposed changes have been provided this date under a separate cover letter to the Commission's Staff and The Office of the Public Counsel.
