## <u>Renew Missouri's Comments re: Ameren</u> Missouri's 2014 Integrated Resource Plan

Renew Missouri supports the comments filed on behalf of the Natural Resources Defense Council ("NRDC") and the Sierra Club with regard to issues such as energy efficiency scenarios, future carbon regulation compliance, coal plant closures, and consideration of alternative resource scenarios.
