ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

Effective Date: March 30, 2007

On March 2, 2007, Osage Valley Technologies, LLC filed an application requesting the Commission cancel their certificate of service authority and tariff to provide interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications service.

In Case Number TA-2001-591, the Commission granted Osage Valley a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications service in the State of Missouri. Osage Valley's tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1, was also approved.

On March 16, 2007, Staff filed its recommendation to cancel Osage Valley's certificate of service authority because it is no longer providing service in Missouri.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and

hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on Osage Valley’s request to cancel its certificate and tariff and Staff’s recommendation, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority and tariff granted to Osage Valley, shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The certificate of authority to provide interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services granted to Osage Valley Technologies, LLC, in Case Number TA-2001-591 is canceled.
2. Osage Valley Technologies, LLC’s tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1, is canceled.
3. This order shall become effective on March 30, 2007.
4. This case may be closed on March 31, 2007.
