APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND FOR COMPETITIVE CLASSIFICATION

@link Networks, Inc. ("@link" or "Applicant"), a Wisconsin corporation, files this verified Application respectfully requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") issue an order that:

- (a) grants Applicant a Certificate of Service Authority to provide all forms of resold and facilities-based basic local telecommunications services in the State of Missouri pursuant to Chapter 392 of the Missouri Revised Statutes;
- (b) grants competitive status to Applicant; and
- (c) waives certain Commission rules and statutory provisions pursuant to Section 392.420, RSMo.

I. The Applicant

1. Applicant is an interexchange telecommunications company with operations in the state of Missouri and other jurisdictions. It previously obtained authority to provide interexchange and non-switched, non-basic local exchange services, pursuant to the Commission Order in Case No. TA-99-150, issued on December 21, 1998. Applicant's legal name is @link Networks, Inc. ("@link" or "Applicant"). Applicant maintains its principal place of business at:

- 2. @link, a Wisconsin corporation, is a direct, wholly owned subsidiary of @link Holdings, Inc., a Delaware corporation. @link is qualified to do business in the State of Missouri. Copies of @link's Certificate of Incorporation and Certificate of Authority to Transact Business in the State of Missouri are attached collectively hereto as Exhibit 1.

- 5. @link seeks authority to provide resold and facilities-based basic local telecommunications services to subscribers to and from the points in the State of Missouri within the exchanges identified subsequently herein. At this time, @link does not seek to terminate any existing rural exemptions existing under Section 251 of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. As mentioned above, Applicant currently has authority to provide interexchange and non-basic, non-switched, local exchange services in the State of Missouri. Applicant's services will be available on a full-time basis, 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
- 6. @link initially intends to provide data transmission services only, but requests authority to provide all forms of basic local exchange telecommunications services including: (1) Basic Residential Exchange Services (local exchange flat rate, measured rate service, operator access, etc.); (2) Residential Custom and Class Features (call waiting, caller ID, call forwarding, etc.); (3) Basic Business Exchange Services; (4) Business Custom Calling and Class Features; (5) Adjunct Provided Features (voice messaging, etc.); and (6) Business and Residential Ancillary Services (911, directory listing, directory assistance, etc.), so that it may expand its service offerings to include voice services in the future.

II. Section 392.455, RSMo Requirements

A. Financial, Technical and Managerial Resources and Abilities

7. @link possesses the financial qualifications required of applicants for the authority requested herein. @link is financially qualified to provide the services described in this application in the State of Missouri. @link has access to the financing and capital necessary to conduct the telecommunications operations as specified in this application. @link will rely upon its existing personnel, technology and financial resources to provide the services described in this application. Attached hereto under seal as Highly Confidential Exhibit 2 is a copy of @link's audited financial

statement for the year ending May 31, 1999 and a copy of @link's financial statement for the six month period ending November 30, 1999. @link submits that this information concerning its financial condition is highly confidential and therefore is being filed under seal and accompanied by a Motion for Protective Order. This exhibit is offered to demonstrate Applicant's financial ability to operate as a basic local telecommunications service provider in the State of Missouri.

- 8. @link is technically and managerially qualified to provide basic local exchange services within the State of Missouri. @link has authority to offer interexchange and non-basic, non-switched local exchange services in the State of Missouri. @link Networks, Inc. (formerly known as Dakota Services, Ltd.) is authorized to provide telecommunications service in Alabama, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Delaware, the District of Columbia, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Vermont, West Virginia, and Wisconsin. Applicant also is authorized to provide data telecommunications service (on an unregulated basis) in Iowa and Wyoming. @link has pending applications for authority to provide telecommunications service in Arizona, Louisiana, Maine, Maryland, and North Carolina. @link has not been denied requested certification in any jurisdiction, nor has it had a permit, license, or certificate revoked by any authority.
- 9. @link proposes to provide service through its own equipment collocated at ILEC central offices, through the use of unbundled network elements leased from other certificated carriers, and/or through the resale of the service of other carriers. Descriptions of the technical and managerial backgrounds of @link's officers and directors, which demonstrate the extensive telecommunications experience and expertise of @link's management team, are attached hereto as

Exhibit 3.

B. <u>Commission Minimum Service Standards</u>

10. @link's basic local telecommunications services will be equal to or superior to the quality of the basic local telecommunications services that customers in the State of Missouri are currently receiving from the incumbent providers. @link will meet all service standards applicable to telecommunications services, including but not limited to billing, quality of service, and the filing and maintenance of tariffs, except as waived by the Commission.

C. Geographic Area in which Applicant Proposes to Offer Service

11. Attached to this Application as Exhibit 4 is a list of all the exchanges in which Applicant proposes to provide service, including the exchanges of the ILECs presently providing basic local service. @link affirms that its service areas will follow ILEC exchange boundaries and will be no smaller than an exchange.

D. Separate and Distinct Service

12. @link will offer basic local telecommunications service as a separate and distinct service pursuant to Section 392.455(4) RSMo.

E. Equitable Access

13. @link will provide equitable access, as determined by the Commission, for all Missourians within the geographic area in which it will offer basic local services in compliance with Section 392.455(5), RSMo. Supp. 1998.

F. <u>Classification as a Competitive Company</u>

also seeks classification as a competitive company, with accompanying reduced regulation, pursuant to Section 392.361.2 and 392.361.3, RSMo. In determining the classification of an applicant, the Commission may consider such factors as market share, financial

resources and name recognition, among others. See In the Matter of the Investigation for the Purpose of Determining the Classification of the Services Provided by Interexchange Telecommunications Companies within the State of Missouri, 30 Mo. P.S.C. (N.S.) 16 (1989); In the Matter of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company's application for Classification of Certain Services as Transitionally Competitive, 1 Mo. P.S.C. 3d 479, 484 (1992). All of the services a competitive company provides must be classified as competitive. @link submits that as a new market entrant, it does not have the market share or name recognition to inhibit competition. To the contrary, the Commission's approval of this Application will create competition for those ILECs that now possess sufficient market share and name recognition to dominate the telecommunications service market in the State of Missouri. Allowing @link to compete with existing ILECs, such as SWBT, GTE and Sprint, will bring benefits such as lower costs and better service to residents of the State of Missouri. The public interest benefits of competition justify a lesser degree of regulation for carriers such as @link.
